

Organ Recital by David Oldfield

at Alltwen Chapel, Pantardawe

David Oldfield was born and educated in Sheffield, at King Edward VII School and then at the Royal Northern College of Music where he studied organ, singing and choral training.

David was Head of Music in several schools, has had several successful posts as organist and choirmaster and has taught organ, piano and singing. He has worked in varying roles for the Royal School of Church Music since 1977 including Housemaster, Course Director and Examiner.

David specialises in early music, Baroque music and 20th/21st century music and has made a special study of Tudor Church Music and the vast choral repertoire of English Church Music.

David actively pursues his interests as a recitalist and also in education and outreach. He directs several choirs - particularly Coro Novus, who sing in cathedrals - and has a less formal association with two others.

The last year has been difficult for all musicians and this is only David's second recital since he played at S Mary's Portsea in February 2020.
